| 1 | breakfast |  | the first daily meal, usually eaten in the morning | 아침 식사 | This morning, I ate a banana for breakfast . |
| 1 | desk |  | a table, usually for writing on | 책상 | I wrote a letter at my desk . |
| 1 | face |  | the front part of the head that includes the eyes, nose and mouth | 얼굴 | She has a pretty face . |
| 1 | late |  | arriving, happening or beginning after the expected time | 늦은 | She was nearly late for school every day. |
| 1 | pajama |  | (plural) loose clothing that is worn for comfort, usually to sleep in | 잠옷 | People wear pajama before go to bed. |







| 2 | teacher |  | a person who teaches others, especially in a school | 교사 | The teacher was late to class today. |
| 2 | wonderful |  | creating feelings of enjoyment and delight | 놀랄만한 | That movie was wonderful . |

| 3 | classroom |  | a room in a school where students take lessons | 교실 | The classroom was empty. |
| 3 | lunchbox |  | a special box used by children to carry their lunches in | 도시락 | He put his lunchbox on his desk. |
| 3 | remember |  | to hold a thought or image from the past in one's mind; to recall something from the past | 기억하고 있다 | I'm sorry I can't remember your name. |
| 3 | wait |  | to remain in particular place until something happens or someone arrives | 기다리다 | I will wait for you at the bus stop. |

| 4 | chip |  | a thin piece of potato or other food that is fried in oil | 감자튀김 | The label on the potato chips said there were 350 calories per serving. |
| 4 | cookie |  | a type of sweet, baked food that is mainly made of flour, sugar, butter and eggs and is usually flat and round | 쿠키 | Stacy bakes some really yummy cookies . |
| 4 | have to |  | to be obligated to do something | ~해야만 하다 | We have to meet later. |
| 4 | rule |  | an official statement which explains how things must be done and what is allowed in a particular system or situation | 규칙 | Do not break a school rule . |

| 5 | handkerchief |  | a small square of cloth | 손수건 | Use this handkerchief to clean your hands. |
| 5 | over |  | above; higher in position than something | ~위쪽에 | There is a bird over us. |
| 5 | piñata |  | a large hollow object made of colorful paper and used at parties (in Mexico), usually filled with candy | 종미(멕시코) 박터트리기 게임 | Have you ever hit a pinata before? |
| 5 | stick |  | a long and thin piece of wood which has broken off or was cut from a tree | 막대기 | A stick is a part of a tree. |




